

Dear Parents,

We will have a mandatory camp parent meeting on Wednesday, May 23rd. Middle School parents will meet at 6pm while High School will meet at 6:30pm. Please print and fill out all medical forms and bring them with you to the meeting. We will also need a copy of your insurance card and your medical form will need to be notarized. Our church secretary will be available during the meeting to notarize your form. We will be able to copy your insurance card as well. Also, please pay your remaining balance for camp at our meeting. If you paid the \$50 deposit, your Middle School balance is \$100 and the High School balance is \$175.

For High School camp, all campers must fill out a track time card. He or she will have the opportunity to choose their top 6 track time options. The Fuge staff will place them in a track time once they arrive at camp. This form has to be submitted electronically by June 1st.

Cell phone policy: Both Middle and High School camp adopts the individual church's policy regarding cell phone use at camp. At Collinsville FBC, our policy is that no cell phones are allowed at Middle School camp. We will provide you with all of our adult chaperone numbers in case you need to reach your child while at camp. For High School, phones are allowed, but are not to be used during Bible study or Worship. If you are on your phone and not participating in camp, it will be taken up and given back once we return home. I encourage you though, to limit your phone usage while at camp. Your phone is your responsibility. The church is not responsible for lost or stolen phones.

If you have any questions, please feel free to call or text. Please join me in praying for our students as we prepare for summer camp. I am looking forward to what God has in store for us!!

CAMP GUIDELINES AND GENERAL INFORMATION

Our goal is for every camper to grow in their relationship with Jesus Christ in a fun and safe environment while building relationships with fellow Christians. This is accomplished by all campers participating in all activities (unless prohibited by a medical condition or disability).

Our rule about cell phones and personal music /game devices is:

First and foremost: Whatever **your church's policy** is on these is what is applicable to **your** group in regards to bringing them to camp. We ourselves do not ban them. If you allow your students to bring these devices, we ask that these guidelines be adhered to:

**they should only be used to call and text (and limited use at that) during free time at church leaders' discretion*

**cell phones can be used during worship/bible study times if campers are using their bible apps*

**cell phones can be used to take pictures and videos of camp activities as allowed by church group leader*

**MBCB and Central Hills are not responsible for lost phones and devices*

Campers are not allowed in anyone else's room without invitation from someone in that room. Boys are **never** allowed in girls' rooms/halls and girls are never allowed in boy's rooms/halls. **Pranks against other campers are not tolerated.** Any damages to camp/campus property will be billed to churches whose students are involved. **Adult counselors are responsible for the conduct of their students at all times.** Adult leaders are to make sure their students do not disturb others at night.

NO firearms, pocketknives, or any types of weaponry are permitted. Fireworks are not permitted. The use of tobacco, alcohol, or illegal drugs is STRICTLY FORBIDDEN. Students who break this rule can be sent home at parents' or church's expense.

ACCOMODATIONS

Students are housed in rooms only with campers from his/her church.

Bunkhouse style with bunk beds sleeping 3-8 per room and common bathroom/shower on hall. Room assignments are made based on availability and all students will only share rooms with students from their church. Adults are housed with students. ***If your church has a policy that adults are not allowed to sleep in rooms with students, please contact us at least 2 weeks before camp.***
